


BEWILDERMENT

“Nobody’s perfect... But, man, we all fall short so beautifully.”

A love story between a widowed father and son, and the world they are both trying to save. Theo Byrne is an astrobiologist working to discover and predict the existence and likelihood of new planets, and the chance of life occurring on them. He is also the caregiver to his nine year old son, Robin. Whip-smart, funny, unusual, and mourning the death of his environmental activist mother, Alyssa.



We follow Theo unwillingly navigating how to be a solo parent after the loss of his wife; trying to raise Robin, who is closer than ever to expulsion and the threat of psycho-somatic drugs after breaking the cheekbone of his only friend. Within Robin we follow a child with a unique and spectacular mind trying to grapple with the destruction of the planet- and those adults that are letting it happen.

Though encompassing broad themes of climate change and activism, political apathy, and extraterrestrial life, Bewilderment thrives in its most intimate scenes, informed by grief and love. What we discover in reading, however, is that the two may not be so different after all. At the centre of Bewilderment lies the question: how can we let our children know what is happening to our planet?

Powers is an established provider of far-reaching, brilliant stories, but we believe that his latest instalment of Bewilderment is strongest in both the truth of characters, and the intimacy of the story itself. “Although I love to paint lots of different subjects, my first love is landscape, specifically, our Australian landscape.”

How long have you been practicing as an artist?

Like so many artists, I'd have to say I don't remember a time when I wasn't being creative! Photography and music were very important in my family and while I love both, it was Art that became my passion. I was introduced to oil painting quite young and entered my first exhibition when I was 12yo. I've always had an art practise in one form or another but it wasn't until recent years when I finally let the day job go that I could say I'm a full-time artist...and loving it!

When do you feel most creative?

It's a feeling that never leaves. However, when I'm in the bush that feeling is definitely heightened. Sometimes it can feel almost overwhelming. Because of this, one of my favourite things to do is to pack a few art supplies and head into the bush for a day of drawing or painting. It feeds everything from the initial inspiration to the way I paint the light and the colours I choose.

What does a typical day in the studio involve?

I like to be in the studio around 8am and finish by 4pm but the reality is I often don't leave until closer to 6 or 7pm. When there is a deadline looming the hours can be much longer. When I arrive in the studio I have a routine I go through every time before I start to paint and the day doesn't feel quite right if I don't do it! First, I put the kettle on and have a little play on the piano while I wait for it to boil. Then, I'll decide if it's a podcast, music or a quiet kind of day. I'll set up



fresh paint, organise brushes etc and, because I work on several works at once, I'll decide which painting is going on the easel and then I'm good to go!

What themes are evident in your work?

Often my work centres around two distinctly different regions - the Upper Blue Mountains and the NSW South Coast. I lived in the Blue Mountains before moving to the coast some 20 years ago and I still move between the two. For me, painting the mountains is like painting the portrait of an old and familiar friend, whilst the coast is still new and exciting... and every work is an opportunity for discovery and connection.

WALKING THROUGH NATURE

Keeping your body moving is a very important aspect in not only your health, but your overall wellbeing too. Fortunately for locals, the Kiama and surrounding area is filled with stunning walking tracks.



The 20-kilometre Kiama Coast Walk will keep your body moving, as well as your eyes, with stunning views of the ocean, beaches, and amazing rock formations. Stretching from Minnamurra River to Gerringong, the walk can be split into three sections. Crossing paths, grass, and sand, the walk is fit for most fitness levels.

Surrounding yourself with nature at Barren Grounds Nature Reserve will do your wellbeing some good. Fit for the family, the walking tracks here will have you seeing cliffs, lookouts, and beautiful flora and fauna.

The Hoddles Track at Saddleback Mountain will keep you busy for up to two hours. This popular

spot for birdwatching will have you entertained. For a quick short walk, the Bonaira Native Gardens is the place for it. With a short path surrounded by flora, a picnic on the forest floor should be on the agenda.

If you need to travel through the streets of Kiama, why not walk it on the Kiama Heritage Walk. Simply walking instead of driving, you will learn all about Kiama's past by reading plaques along the way.
