We operate a local preference policy and a preference for home made or crafted goods.

In our quest to deliver the best Sunday market in the NSW South Coast **presentation is key** to all stallholders we include in the market. Please only apply if your presentation is of a very high standard.

### **Health and Wellbeing Products and Services**

- If you plan to provide a service in the market, (for example massage or reflexology) you will need to provide certification of relevant training and experience.
- Handmade, locally sourced or organic health products are preferred over mass produced or globally available health products.
- Branded health products that are available in retail outlets or pharmacies are not encouraged.

### **Gifts, Fashion and Merchandise Products**

- Handmade, hand crafted or locally sourced products are favoured over imported products as we support local creative industries.
- Fashion that is designed and made in Australia is preferred over imported fashion products.
- We support local artists, artisans and creators wherever possible.

### **Food and Food Products**

- We support local growers under our local preference policy
- We support local artisan bakers and food producers.
- We aim to showcase the best of local produce for market visitors.
- We aim to offer fresh and healthy options in the market.
- As a courtesy we consider the permanent traders in Kiama, and therefore cannot accept hot food or beverage applications. There are amazing cafes and restaurants in our town to sample from.
- We aim to offer gourmet take-home products for the pantry showcasing the best of Kiama and Districts produce.
